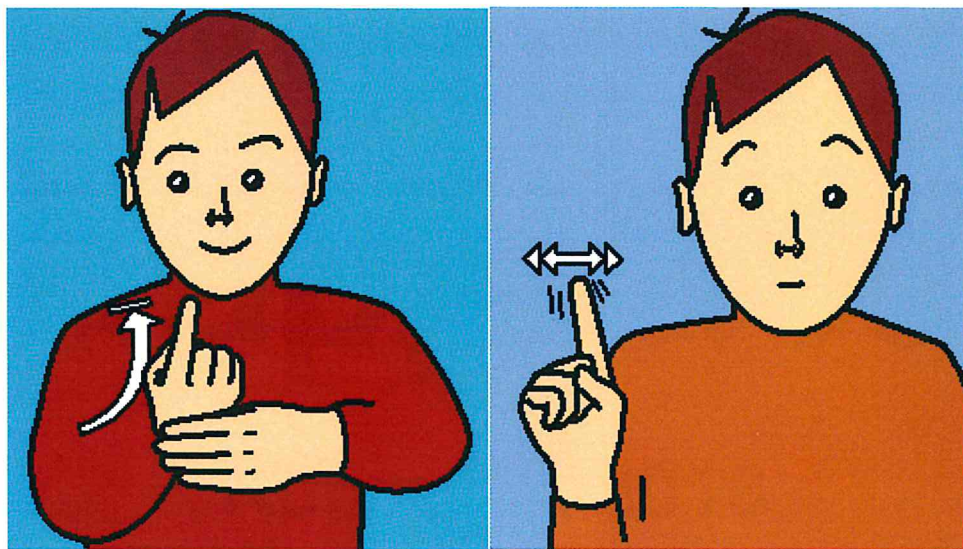

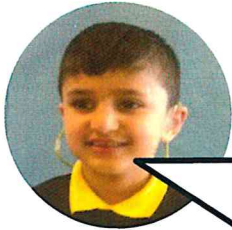

My favourite thing has been learning about plants and seeds. I like the hamster

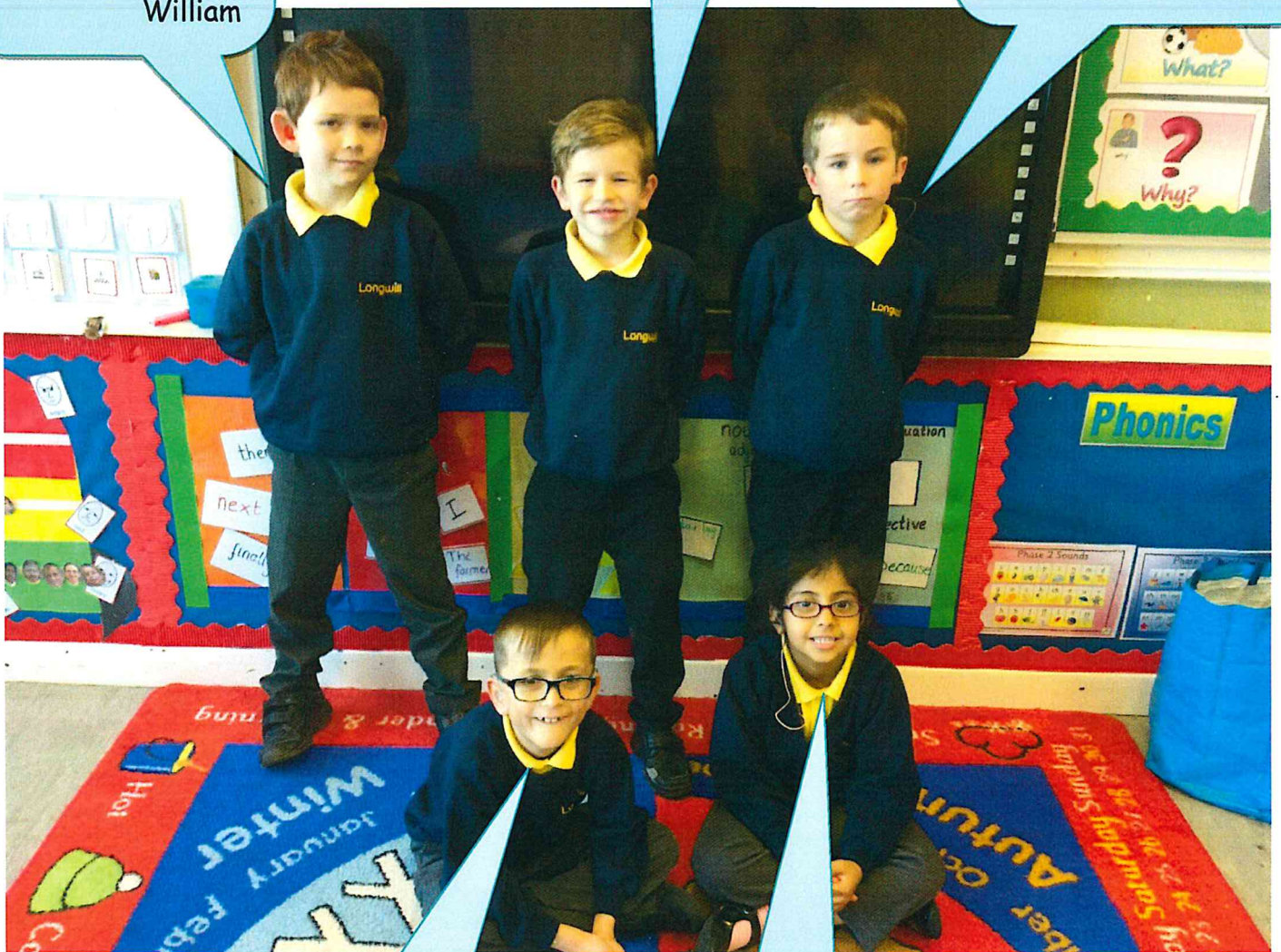

I have enjoyed learning about giving directions in Maths. It was fun telling Ahmad to go left or right. I like to do maths outside.

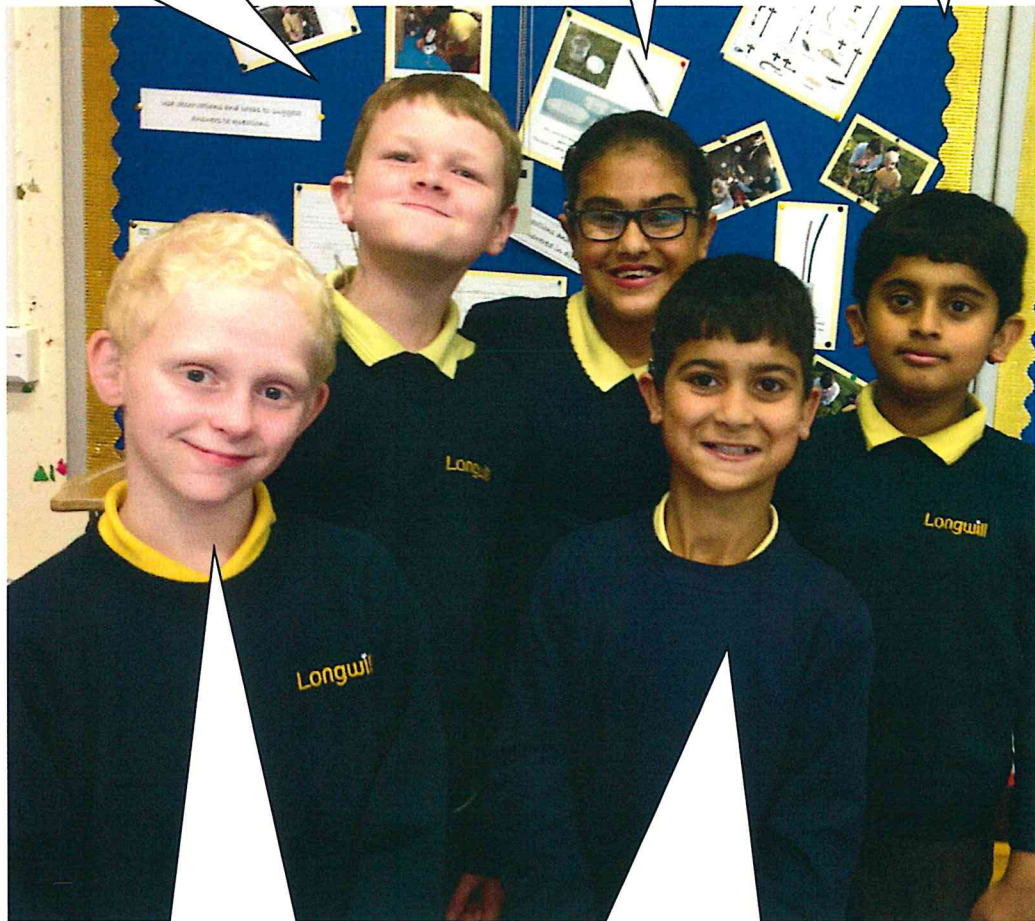


What's Happened Y6 Autumn A
